Response Review





On September 12th, 2023 we were requested by the Michigan State Police and Lawrence Twp Emergency Services to assist on a missing aircraft search for 3 days. The pilot departed on 9/10/23 around 11am and had not been seen since. Extensive coordination between MSP, Cass County Authorities, Van Buren Authorities, Civil Air Patrol and the Air Force Rescue Coordination Center lead to the discovery of the aircraft in Silver Creek Twp on 9/14/23 within the 2 mile arrival/departure path of Dowagiac Municipal Airport. The extensive coordination between fixed wing, rotary wing and UAS operations was a testament to safety tiered aerial operations.

Remote ID Update:

Effective September 16th, 2023 remote ID (RID) is now required by the FAA for all drone flights within the US National Airspace. The FAA has provided some exemptions as well as provided a delayed enforcement MEMO to all investigators that allows a until March 16th, 2024 to become compliant if the pilot shows proof of attempts to be compliant due to product availability delays.

Anyone can now monitor a drones location in the air via a free phone app. We currently recommend <u>Air Sentinel</u> which is a free android based app you can download. They do have an IOS version coming out in November 2023. If you are a public safety agency, you can also see the pilots location after a vetting process with Air Sentinel.
