Our website is www.oli.org Our goal is to keep NON-RAILROAD people from getting injured or killed on railroad tracks or property.

- 1. Stop people trespassing on railroad rights of way
- 2. Concern about drivers not stopping at flashing lights or going around crossing gates
- 3. Build respect for people and railroads
- 4. Save lives and reduce injuries in the community
- 5. Promote awareness of the Blue Emergency Notification Signs (ENS) at crossings and how they can prevent incidents (Sign example above.)

Berrien County has many high-speed trains on two lines. Emphasis has been put on Berrien County because of the Lakeside Road Accident in November 2023, where a vehicle was stuck on the tracks and was hit (no personal injuries) by an Amtrak train. We need to find ways to keep that from happening in the future.
