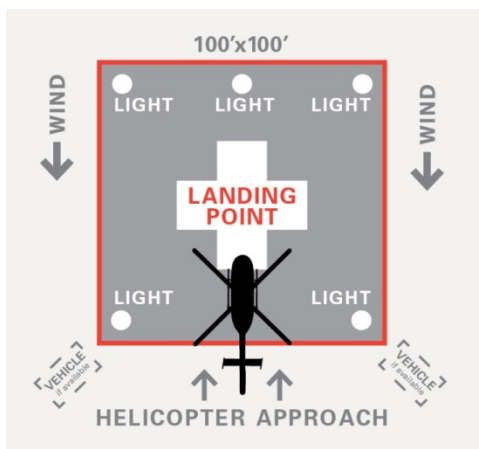


## ***Landing Zone Guidelines***

- Size – at least 100 feet x 100 feet
- Slope – relatively flat (minimal slope)
- Surface – firm, free of debris, equipment
- Approach and departure paths free of obstructions
- Identify hazards in proximity to LZ
- At night, mark LZ with red or amber strobes or similar, well secured lights.
- Do not shine lights directly at helicopter
- Flares and barrier tape are not recommended for marking LZ
- Do not use personnel to mark the LZ corners
- Keep spectators and vehicles at least 200 feet away from LZ
- After landing, do not approach the helicopter, wait for air medical crew to approach you
- Establish Landing Zone Supervisor to manage LZ
- Maintain security of LZ throughout entire event
- Always follow the instructions of the air medical crew
- Maintain Safety Focus and Situational Awareness
